4. (b) Provision of assistance of Scribe

PwD candidates who have not less than 40% permanent disability and have limitation in writing shall have the option to use his/her own scribe with due permission of the Commission. The intending candidates have to give option for scribe in the online application form. They have to submit the required information in the prescribed format as per Appendix-I and Appendix-II of the Advisory Notice No.3453/OSSC Dtd.24.10.2019 (available in the Commission's website) when asked to do so by the Commission.

5. Remuneration of the post and Condition of service:

The appointment to the post will be initially on contractual basis carrying remuneration of Rs.13, 100/- per month (for 1st year) as per Govt. In GA & PG Department Notification No.28621/Gen. Dated 27.10.2021 and conditions of service shall be guided as per Odisha Group-C & Group-D posts (Contractual Appointment) Rules, 2013 amended update as well as Odisha Sub-Ordinate Fisheries Service (Recruitment & Conditions of Services) Rules, 2013.

6. Eligibility:

(a) <u>Age</u>:

(i) The minimum age for the post is 21 years and the maximum age is 38 years as on 01-01-2021. The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years for candidates belonging to SEBC, SC, ST & all Women candidates, 10 years for candidates belonging to PwD category & the total period of service rendered in Defence Service in case of Ex-servicemen. PwD candidates in the ST & SC category shall be entitled to cumulative age relaxation of ten years over & above the normal relaxation specified for the category. However, a candidate can only avail one type of age relaxation most beneficial to him/her as per rule. To be eligible, candidates not enjoying any relaxation of upper age limit must not have been born earlier than 2nd January, 1983 and not later than 1st January 2000. The persons in Defence Forces not having more than six months to retire/ discharge from the forces as on the last date of the submission of online application are eligible to apply as ex-serviceman for the post. However such candidates have to submit the discharge certificate on the date of certificate verification for considering their claims under Ex-Serviceman category.

Border Security Force, Indian Coast Guard, CRPF and other Para Military Forces are not within the definition of Ex-Servicemen.

Note: Once an Ex-Serviceman has joined the Govt. Service in civil side after availing the benefit as an Ex-Serviceman for his re-employment, his ex-serviceman status for the purpose of re-employment in Govt. Jobs shall cease to exist. He can avail age relaxation only. However as per clause-4 of the O.M. No. 36034/2014-Estt.(Res) dt.14 August,2014 of Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Personnel & Training, Government of India, if an Ex-Serviceman applies for various posts before joining any civil employment, he/she can avail of the benefit of reservation as ex-serviceman for any subsequent employment, provided the applicant as soon as joins any civil employment, should give self-declaration/undertaking to the concerned employer about the date-wise details of application for various posts for which he/she had applied for before joining. The applicant should furnish the copy of above declaration duly endorsed by the employer on the date of Document Verification for consideration of the claim of reservation under Ex-Serviceman category.

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However, the upper age limit is relaxable for in-service contractual employees engaged by the Govt. or through manpower service provider agencies in the State Govt. offices or the State Govt. of Odisha who have completed at least one year of continuous service prior to commencement of the said rules as per provision of "Odisha Group-C & D posts (Contractual appointment) Rules, 2013" shall get age relaxation. As such they must be less than 45 years as on 01.01.2021. They should submit the required proof from their employer (as furnished in detail in Clause-9) for availing the age relaxation at the time of certificate verification.

6(b) Date of birth entered in the High School certificate Examination by the Board of Secondary Education, Odisha or equivalent Certificate issued by the recognised Board/Council/ by an Indian University as equivalent there to shall only be acceptable to the Commission.

7. (a) Educational Qualification:-

The candidate must have possessed +2 Vocational (Fisheries) from CHSE/University and must know swimming well. Candidates possessing +2 Science qualifications will also be eligible to apply for the post. But when candidates possessing +2 Vocational (Fisheries) qualifications will not be available, candidates with +2 Science qualifications will be considered for selection.

7 (b). The candidates must know swimming well. He/She has to declare to this effect in the online application form.

7(c) General Eligibility Criteria

In order to be eligible for appearing in the examination a candidate must satisfy the following conditions.

- The candidate must be a citizen of India. (i)
- Be able to speak, read & write Odia. (ii)
- Be of good moral character & conduct. (iii)
- Be of good mental condition and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the discharge of his duties in the service. - Candidate must have passed Middle School Examination with Odia as a language subject, or have passed High School Certificate Examination or equivalent (vi) examination with Odia as a subject/medium of examination in non-Language subject, or have passed in Odia as a language subject in the final examination of Class VII or above or have passed a test in Odia in M.E. School Standard conducted by the School & Mass Education Department.

NB: Not fulfilling of any of the eligibility criteria shall render the applicant's candidature invalid & rejected.

8. Examination Fee:

The candidates other than SC/ST/PwD (having Permanent Disability) category have to pay a non-refundable examination fee of Rs. 200/-. Freshwater aquaculture resources- ponds, tanks, lakes and reservoirs. ursery, rearing and grow out pond preparation and management, control of aquatic weeds, predatory and weed fishes, algal blooms, liming, fertilization/manuring, use of biofertilizers, stocking, feeding to fishes, pond environment management, fish health management, harvesting.

Unit-IV

Freshwater prawn culture and important species for culture, seed stocking and culture practices, brackish water aquaculture, important finfishes and shellfishes for

culture, collection of seed, stocking, important species for culture, seed stocking, culture practices.

Unit-V

ANNEXURE - II

CHEMISTRY

Unit I: Some Basic Concepts of Chemistry

Atomic and molecular masses and equivalent mass of elements, acid, base, and salt,oxidants,reductants, and mole concept and molar mass, percentage composition, empirical and molecular formula, chemical reactions, stoichiometry and calculations based on stoichiometry, expression of concentration of solutions.

Unit II: Structure of Atom

Atomic number, isotopes, isobars, Rutherford's model and its limitations, Bohr's model and its limitations, concept of shells and subshells, dual nature of matter and light, de Broglie's relationship, Heisenberg uncertainty principle, concept of orbitals, quantum numbers, shapes of s, p and d orbitals, rules for filling electrons in orbitals — Aufbau principle, Pauli's exclusion principle and Hund's rule, electronic configuration of atoms, stability of half filled and fully filled orbitals.

Unit III: Classification of Elements and Periodicity in Properties

Modern periodic law and the present form of periodic table, periodic trends in properties of elements - atomic radii ionic radii, inert gas radii, Ionization enthalpy, electron gain enthalpy, electronegativity, valency and oxidation state. Nomenclature of elements with atomic number greater than 100.

Unit IV: Chemical Bonding and Molecular Structure

Valence electrons, ionic bond, covalent bond; bond parameters, Lewis structure, polar character of covalent bond, covalent character of ionic bond, valence bond theory, resonance, geometry of covalent molecules, VSEPR theory, concept of hybridization, involving s, p and d orbitals and shapes of some molecules, molecular orbital theory of homonuclear diatomic molecules (qualitative idea only), hydrogen bond.

Unit V: States of Matter: Gases and Liquids

Role of gas laws in elucidating the concept of the molecule, Boyle's law, Charles law, Gay Lussac's law, Avogadro's law, ideal behaviour, empirical derivation of gas equation, Avogadro's number, ideal gas equation. Deviation from ideal behaviour liquefaction of gases, critical temperature, kinetic energy and molecular speeds (elementary idea).

Unit VI: Chemical Thermodynamics

Concepts of System and surroundings and types of system, surroundings, work, heat, energy, extensive and intensive properties, state functions.

First law of thermodynamics - Internal energy and enthalpy. Hess's law of constant heat summation, enthalpy of bond dissociation, combustion, formation, neutralization, atomization, sublimation, phase transition, ionization, solution and dilution, Second law of

Thermodynamics (brief introduction). Introduction of entropy as a state function, Gibb's energy change for spontaneous and non-spontaneous processes, criteria for equilibrium.

Third law of thermodynamics (Statement only).

Unit VII: Equilibrium

Equlibrium in physical and chemical processes, dynamic nature of equlibrium, law of mass action, equilibrium constant (Kc, Kp and Kx and their relationship), factors affecting equilibrium, Le- Chatelier's principle, ionic equilibrium, ionization of acids and bases, strong and weak electrolytes, degree of ionization, concept of PH, hydrolysis of salts (elementary idea), buffer solution, Henderson Equation, solubility, product, common ion effect (with illustrative examples) numerical problems.

Unit VIII: Redox Reaction

Concept of oxidation and reduction, redox reactions, oxidation number, balancing redox reactions, in terms of loss and gain of electrons and change in oxidation number.

Unit IX : Hydrogen

Position of hydrogen in periodic table, occurrence, isotopes, preparation, properties and uses of hydrogen, hydrides-ionic, covalent and interstitial; physical and chemical properties of water, heavy water and use of hydrogen as a fuel.

Unit X: s-Block Elements (Alkali and Alkaline Earth Metals)

Group 1 and Group 2 Elements

General introduction, electronic configuration, occurrence, anomalous, properties of the first element of each group, diagonal relationship, trends in the variation of properties (such as ionization enthalpy, atomic and ionic radii), trends in chemical reactivity with oxygen and halogens, uses.

Unit XI: Some p- Block Elements

General Introduction to p- Block Elements

Group 13 Elements: General introduction, electronic configuration, occurrence, variation of properties, oxidation states, trends in chemical reactivity, anomalous properties of first element of the group, Boron - physical and chemical properties.

Group 14 Elements: General introduction, electronic configuration, occurrence, variation of properties, oxidation states, trends in chemical reactivity, anomalous behaviour of first elements. Carbon-catenation, allotropic forms, physical and chemical properties; uses of some important compounds: oxides. Important compounds of Silicon, Silicones, Zeolites and

Unit XII: Organic Chemistry - Some Basic Principles and Technique

General introduction, classification and IUPAC nomenclature of organic compounds. Electronic displacements in a covalent bond, inductive effect, electromeric effect, resonance and hyperconjugation. Homolytic and heterolytic fission of a covalent bond free radicals, carbocations, carbanions, electrophiles and nucleophiles, types of organic reactions.

Unit XIII: Hydrocarbons

Classification of Hydrocarbons

Aliphatic Hydrocarbons:

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Alkanes - Nomenclature, isomerism, conformation (ethane only), methods of preparation from unsaturated hydrocarbons, alkyl halides, carboxylic acids (Decarboxylation and Kolbes electrolytic method), physical properties, chemical reactions: including free radical mechanism of halogenation, combustion, controlled oxidation, isomerisation, aromatisation, with steam and pyrolysis.

Alkenes - Nomenclature, structure of double bond (ethene), geometrical isomerism, methods of preparation from alkynes, alkyl halides, vicinal dihalides, alcohols, physical properties, chemical reactions: addition of hydrogen, halogen, water, hydrogen halides, sulphuric acid (Markownikoff's addition and peroxide effect), ozonolysis, oxidation, polymerisation and mechanism of electrophilic addition reaction.

Alkynes - Nomenclature, structure of triple bond (ethyne), methods of preparation, from calcium carbide, vicinal dihalides, physical properties, chemical reactions: acidic character of alkynes, addition of hydrogen, halogens, hydrogen halides, water, and polymerisation.

Aromatic Hydrocarbons: Introduction, IUPAC nomenclature, benzene: resonance, aromaticity, preparation of benzene from acetylene, phenol and aromatic acids, chemical properties: mechanism of electrophilic substitution, nitration, sulphonation, halogenation, priedel Craft's alkylation and acylation, addition of hydrogen, addition of chlorine, combustion.
